The winners will be profiled in the August issue of *SP&M* and honored at the CEFPI's 86th Annual Conference.

Criteria for Judging:

- Does the solution reflect the challenge presented?
- Is the solution innovative/creative?
- Is the solution cost effective?
- Most importantly — Does the solution enhance student learning?

Entry Requirements:

Projects must be completed between 1/1/2006 and 6/1/2009.

THREE COPIES of the following must be provided:

1. Completed entry form.
2. Descriptive narrative (2-page maximum) that outlines: a) the challenge/problem faced; b) your solution; c) results achieved; and d) how it impacted learning.
3. Floor plans for the project/building, if applicable.
4. Color photos of the solution. Include both before and after photos for modernization projects. Be sure to label photos. Include children portraying the appropriate use of the space whenever possible. At least one set of the photos must be high-quality glossy prints suitable for use in the publication.

IN ADDITION to hard copy narrative and photos for judging, please provide a CD with electronic files containing project narrative and photos. Electronic photos must be: minimum of 300 DPI; minimum size of 4"X6"; .JPG file format. Peter Li Education Group reserves the right to use these photographs for editorial and/or promotional purposes.
